

Adjusting the date bands on the Trodat 4000 Rubber Stamp

- 1) Extremely heavy use will result in the date bands getting pushed "up" under the impression rubber like this:




Notice you cannot see the white date bands.

- 2) To "lower" the date bands back down, the user needs to adjust the screws on each side of the mount. The screws must be turned **CLOCKWISE** (to the right) to lower the dates. To make sure you are turning the screws the correct way, place the stamp impression-down on a table with the TRODAT 4000 logo facing **AWAY** from the user. Using a screwdriver, turn each screw to the **RIGHT**.



With the TRODAT logo facing out, turn the each screw to the right, approximately 2-3 full turns.

- 3) After turning both screws 2-3 full turns, the date bands will be lowered beyond the impression. If the date band has been lowered too far below the impression, simply repeat the process, but turn each screw **COUNTER-CLOCKWISE** (to the left) to "raise" the date bands until the desired level is reached.



Notice the date bands are now above the impression.
